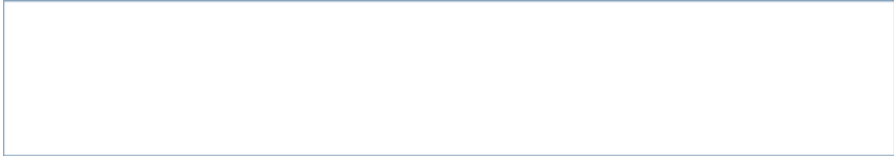

- Laboratory Stewardship: LabRATS Training for Comprehensive Energy and Resource Conservation in Laboratories**

Description: With their resource intensive operations, laboratories provide many opportunities for energy and resource conservation, yet occupant-based efficiency requires a team approach from all corners of campus. High performance requires scientists' understanding and enrollment, safety codes must be met, and energy upgrades and settings must be feasible for facilities staff and energy managers. This half-day workshop will highlight energy savings in plug load, lighting, and heating, ventilation and air conditioning that are available through this team approach. Participants will be provided with survey tools, website models, collaboration strategies, survey tools, internship descriptions, promotional stickers, signs, and template memos.

Teams of facilities or design staff, students, safety personnel and sustainability officers are encouraged to participate so an integrated approach can develop on your campus. The Laboratory Research And Technical Staff approaches at UC Santa Barbara and Davis will be highlighted, with more than eight different conservation programs highlighted that include water, green chemistry, solid waste, and surplus equipment. Workshop participants will be requested to bring their most pressing issues to develop strategies during the workshop.
